THE MEET - Sheep Pens on Apedale Moor, Reeth 9.00 a.m. each day.
From Grinton follow Redmire sign off B6270 then first right (Redmire). After 2.6 miles take first right by cattle grid signed Public Bridleway. Follow track 0.7 miles to sheep pens. From Redmire follow Redmire/Grinton moorland road 1.9 miles. Turn left after first cattle grid.

THE DRAW Will take place at the Meet each day

TRANSPORT/ LUNCHEON Competitors & Spectators must make their own arrangements.

FIRST DAY – Monday 27th July 2026

STAKE 1 PUPPY STAKE

for Pointers and Setters under the age of two years at the scheduled date of the Stake

STAKE 2 OPEN POINTER STAKE

for Pointers of any age

This meeting is restricted to 45 entries on the first day & 40 on the second day. Preference on the first day will be given to Stake 2, which may result in Stake 1 becoming non-qualifying

SECOND DAY- Tuesday 28th July 2026

STAKE 3 OPEN POINTER & SETTER STAKE

for Pointers & Setters of any age (limited to 40 entries)

Stakes 2 and 3 qualify towards the title of Field Trial Champion and towards entry in the Pointer and Setter Champion Stake

Preference in the draw shall be given in the following order:

- a) Members' dogs which have gained a First, Second, or Third award in an Open Stake; or a First or two Second awards in All-Aged, Novice, or Puppy stakes.
- b) Non-Members' dogs as in (a) above.
- c) Members' dogs, which have gained other awards.
- d) Non-Members' dogs as in (c) above.
- e) Other dogs.

The foregoing awards must have been gained in a stake qualifying for entry in The Kennel Club Stud Book. If a competitor enters more than one similarly qualified dog, his first 'preferred' dog must be balloted for in the normal manner. 'Second' and subsequent dogs must then be placed in separate ballots before entries are drawn from other categories. Awards must be stated on the entry form.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at The Royal Kennel Club (RKC) Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the RKC in accordance with RKC Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. The Pointer Club reserves the right to refuse any entry.
3. Substitutes can be accepted for bitches in season providing the substitute is eligible for the Stake and no reserves are standing.
4. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a RKC Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
5. If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot.
6. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes, and the circumstances surrounding them, will be reported to RKC.
7. No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of RKC, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
8. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.
9. Videography and photographs may only be taken with the permission of the Chief Steward.
10. **WELFARE OF DOGS.** An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a RKC licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under RKC Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any field trial licensed by the RKC. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the trial.
11. **DOGS IN HOT CARS ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
12. Out of respect for the generosity of our host, competitors should try to ensure their dogs are competent and are capable of maintaining the standard required.
13. Any bitch in season must be removed from the Ground and from the Trial immediately.
14. Under no circumstances are dogs to be run on the Trial Grounds before the Trials. The Owner(s) of any dogs(s) so found will have his/their entries disqualified. His/their entry fee(s) forfeited, and future entries refused.
15. All Persons attending this meeting must consider themselves under the control of the Field Trial Secretary, Chief Steward, Stewards and Officials of the Club. Persons attending Field Trials should conduct themselves and be appropriately dressed according to the shooting fields practice and custom.
16. If a competitor or anyone in their household has Covid 19 related symptoms or has tested positive for Covid 19 they must follow Government advise and should consider whether it is appropriate that they attend the event.
17. Should any Stake be abandoned due to adverse weather conditions or cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances 50% of the entry fee will be returned.
